RESPONSE TO SGX QUERIES ON DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION IN NEWSPAPER ARTICLE IN BUSINESS TIMES ON 20 APRIL 2010

The Board of Directors of CSE Global Limited (the "Company") wishes to announce the following information in response to queries received from the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited ("SGX-ST") on 20 April 2010 in relation to an article in the Business Times on 20 April 2010.

The queries from SGX-ST and the Company's corresponding responses are set out below:

SGX-ST's queries:

We note the following statements in the announcement contains information which previously have not been announced: -

- (1) Two-thirds of the Company's growth will come from acquisition.
- (2) CSE is currently on the lookout for technology companies control automation, telecommunications and security in minerals and oil & gas in Australia and the Middle East.
- (3) Having come into the current financial year with a project backlog of some \$390 million, he expects this to balloon to \$600 million, thanks to a revival of energy spending around the world and increased spending by the UK healthcare systems.

Company's response to query (1):

Acquisition is part of the growth strategy that CSE pursue since initial public offering (IPO) in 1999. This strategy has been re-iterated as and when possible during our quarterly briefings. Since IPO, approximately two-thirds of the Company's growth came from past acquisitions.

Company's response to query (2):

As acquisition is part of CSE's growth strategy, it is always on the lookout for potential acquisition target. CSE acquires to strengthen its geographical presence as well as its products, services and solutions portfolio. Thus, as CSE sees buoyant downstream oil & gas activities in the Middle East and Africa and future opportunities in the mining and mineral, LNG and coal seam gas in Australia (announced as part of FY2009 results briefing presentation on 26 February 2010), it is in line with its strategy to strengthen geographical presence to lookout for opportunities there.

Company's response to query (3):

CSE recorded new orders received of \$280 million and \$524 million of new orders for 2nd half of FY2009 and full year of FY2009 respectively, announced on 26 February 2010 (Full-year result briefing) and 25 February 2010 (Full-year result announcement). At the current run-rate, CSE is likely to record up to \$600 million of new orders in the current financial year.
